



Loveta Hartle

August 9, 1917 - April 3, 2015

Loveta Hartle, age 97, of Huntington, died at 12:55 a.m. Friday (April 3, 2015) at The Heritage of Huntington.

Visitation will be from 3 - 7 p.m. Monday (April 6, 2015) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington. Funeral Services will be at 11:00 a.m. Tuesday (April 7, 2015) at Bailey-Love Mortuary with one hour of visitation prior to service. Rev. Galen Lowery and Rev. Richard Strick will be officiating. Burial will be in Star of Hope Cemetery in Huntington County.

Loveta was born on August 9, 1917 in Warren Township, Bippus, Indiana, the daughter of Owen and Delia (Denney) Burkart. She was a 1935 graduate of Andrews High School and a 1939 graduate of Nannette Beauty School in South Bend. Loveta married Eugene Hartle on April 10, 1943 at Fort Bliss in El Paso, Texas, and he preceded her in death on November 11, 2005.

Loveta was the owner of the former Hartle Beauty Shop for over 30 years and worked as a hairdresser for over 40 years. She also worked for Juergens Do-It Center as a sales clerk for eight years. She was a member of St. Peter's

First Community Church, where she belonged to the Women's Fellowship, the Friendship Circle, and taught Sunday school in the elementary department. Loveta was a member of the Dandelions, Huntington (College) University Auxiliary, Republican Women's Organization, and volunteered at the Huntington Memorial Hospital and the Dan Quayle Museum.

Survivors include one daughter and son-in-law - Lee Ann and Galen Lowery of Milford, Michigan; foster family - David and Jackie Geimer of Decatur; two sisters - Veva Schilling and Barbara Beckwith, both of Huntington; two grandsons - Dr. Wade Lowery and Derek Lowery; one great grandson - Roman Lowery; three foster grandchildren - Brandy Lawson, Heather and Justin Geimer; and two foster great grandsons - Zach and Trevor Swygart.
