Lucy Mae Shoemaker Crayton was born June 22, 1922 in Huntington, Indiana the daughter of Harley and Phoebe (Zinsmeister) Crook. She died at Clarehouse in Tulsa, Oklahoma on Friday, June 11, 2010. She was 87 years, 11 months and 20 days of age.

The former Miss Lucy Crook was the Valedictorian of the 1940 graduating Class of Andrews High School in Indiana. She was married to Carl H. Shoemaker on June 15, 1941 in Huntington, Indiana, he preceded her in death on February 12, 1973. She married Arthur G. Crayton on August 28, 1977 in Fort Wayne, Indiana, he preceded her in death on April 18, 1984. Mrs. Crayton worked some 15 years at Wabash Magnetics in the Cast Department. She also was the Secretary to the City Beverage in Huntington, Indiana until her retirement on January 7, 1988. She moved to Broken Arrow, Oklahoma from Fort Wayne, Indiana in 2003. Lucy enjoyed Sewing, Genealogy, Painting, Indy Car Racing and was an avid Yankee Baseball Fan. She was a member of AARP and the First Christian Church.

in death by a son, Larry A. Shoemaker, a Granddaughter, Ann Marie Chapin and a special companion, Edwin Blech.
