Luther S. Fusselman, age 91, of Huntington, died at 7:00 a.m. Sunday (December 27, 2009) at Heritage Pointe, Warren.

Luther was born on June 7, 1918 in Wells County, Indiana to Otto and Rose (Koontz) Fusselman. He married Louise Campbell on May 18, 1940 in Huntington. Louise preceded him in death on February 3, 2001.

Luther retired as a farmer in Lancaster Township in 1980. He also worked for Orton Crane in Huntington for 3 years, Caswell Runyan, Huntington, for 13 years and was a truck driver for Locke Steel Chain in Huntington for 20 years. Luther was a member of the Loon Creek Church of the Brethren.

Survivors include one son – Dennis E. (Barbara) Fusselman of Huntington; one daughter – Mrs. Lawrence (Donna C.) Storey of Huntington; one sister – Margaret Helmke of Fort Wayne; eight grandchildren, sixteen great-grandchildren, and one great-great-grandchild.
