M. Marjorie Kiracofe, age 94, of Warren, formerly of Huntington, passed away peacefully at 1:15 p.m. Wednesday (April 6, 2016) at Heritage Pointe in Warren, where she resided for the past 23 years. She was born on March 16, 1922 in Huntington to Tom (T.R.) and Clarissa Pauling and was a lifelong resident of Huntington prior to moving to Warren. She was married to D. Eugene Kiracofe who preceded her in death in 1998. Together they shared 56 years of marriage.

Mrs. Kiracofe graduated from Huntington High School then attended Huntington College and Manchester College. She worked for many years as Membership Secretary at Trinity United Methodist Church and later served as Administrative Assistant to the President at Huntington College. She was a member of Trinity UMC her entire life where her family's membership has spanned more than 100 years.

Left to cherish her memory are four sons, John (Sharon), Austin, TX; Phil (Mary Lee), Tallahassee, FL; Roderick (Jack Eiman), San Francisco, CA; Mark (Melita), Portland, TN; eight grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.
