



Madalyn Anne Zinsmeister

August 22, 1943 - January 15, 2019

Madalyn Anne Zinsmeister, age 75, of Huntington, died of a stroke at 3:45 p.m. Tuesday, January 15, 2019 at St. Vincent North in Indianapolis, peacefully surrounded by her family.

Visitation will be from 3 – 7 p.m. Friday, January 25, 2019 at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Saturday at Faith Chapel United Methodist Church, 2978 West 1100 North, Huntington, with Pastor Jason Parsons officiating. There will be one hour of visitation prior to the service. Burial will be in Beech Grove Cemetery in Huntington County.

Madalyn was born on August 22, 1943 in Huntington, the daughter of Robert F. and Mary E. (Tyner) Warner. She was a graduate of Clear Creek High School and married James E. Zinsmeister on May 20, 1962 at Beech Grove Church; he preceded her in death on July 27, 1971. Madalyn worked at Pyle Industries for 10 ½ years and retired from Bippus State Bank after 10 years. She was a life-long member of Faith Chapel United Methodist Church and dearly loved her family and friends.

Survivors include two daughters, Ladema (Amy) Zinsmeister of Indianapolis; Lisa (Steve) Hedges of Indianapolis; and a son Joseph E. (Crystal) Zinsmeister of Logansport. Grandchildren Lauren Hedges, Erica Hedges, James Zinsmeister, Jessica Biehl, Kristie Biehl and a great grandson, Grayson Biehl. Also surviving are a brother, Max (Jackie) Warner of Huntington and sisters Marcia Ruschhaupt of Huntington and Millie (Dennis) Thornton of Huntington. Her parents and husband precede her in death.

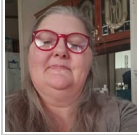

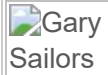

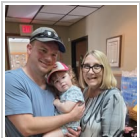
