Marguerite K. "Maggie" Schroeder, age 95, of Huntington, died at 11:57 a.m. Sunday, January 8, 2017 at Heritage of Huntington.

She was co-owner of Schroeder Grocery Store with her husband from 1950-1957, and then worked for the Kroger Regional Office in Fort Wayne, where she retired. Maggie was a member of St. Peter's First Community Church in Huntington and she loved to travel. She also enjoyed volunteering at the Quayle Center, Heritage of

Huntington, and Heritage Pointe in Warren though 2014.

Survivors include two sons - Jim (Linda) Schroeder of Warren and Gary (Sue) Schroeder of Wheeling, Illinois; a brother - Harold Schoeff of Fort Wayne; three granddaughters - Alexandria Kalous, Bernadine Berry, and Claudine Schroeder; and eight great grandchildren. She is preceded in death by her parents, husband, and two brothers, Paul Schoeff and Max Schoeff.

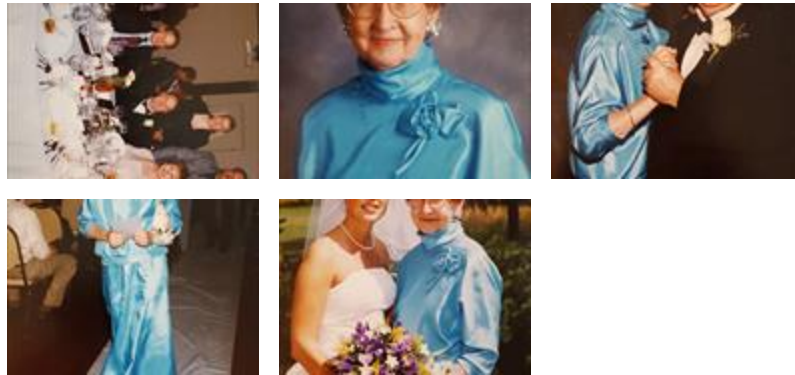
