Marjorie D. Richardson, age 89, of Huntington, died at 3:45 a.m. Tuesday (May 12, 2015) at Oakbrook Village in Huntington.

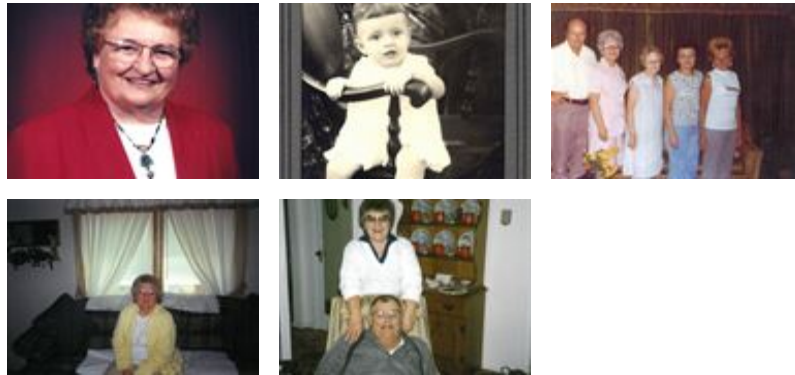
