Mark W. Parrett, 78, of Huntington, passed away at 3:30 pm Sunday, December 25, 2022, at Markle Health & Rehabilitation.

Mark was born on April 20, 1944, in Huntington, IN, the son of Arthur Parrett and F. Mary Wood. He graduated from Huntington High School with the class of 1964. Mark married Sylvia A.
