Mark E. Sunderman, age 83, of Huntington, died at 4:35 a.m. Sunday (September 8, 2013) at Parkview Regional Medical Center, Fort Wayne, Indiana.

Family will receive friends from 2-6 p.m. Sunday (September 15, 2013) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Mark was born February 8, 1930 in Warren, Indiana, the son of Rufus and Hazel (Bussard) Sunderman. He graduated in 1948 from Jefferson Township High School. Mark was a veteran of the United States Army. After his service in the military, he married Jacquelyn Goslee on November 26, 1953 at the Jefferson Center United Methodist Church in Warren, Indiana. They shared 55 years of marriage before she preceded him in death on April 26, 2008.

Mark retired in 1992 from Indiana Bell/AT&T Telephone Companies in

Huntington. Prior to that, he worked at the Public Service Power Company also in Huntington. He was a member for over 70 years of The Jefferson Center United Methodist Church, (now merged into The Solid Rock United Methodist Church). He was a lifelong fan of the Chicago Cubs.

Survivors include his two daughters - Teresa "Teri" Sunderman (David Uttermohlen) of Granger and Joan (Goven) Sunderman Martinez of Hyattsville, Maryland; one son - Steven M. (Sally Michel) Sunderman of Lafayette; five grandchildren - Lisa, Amanda, Michael, Tom and Lauren and three great-grandchildren - Lily, Austin and Addison. His parents and a brother - Jack Sunderman preceded him in death.
