Mark E. Nielsen, age 58, Huntington, died at 3:23 a.m. Wednesday (June 17, 2009) at Parkview Hospital, Fort Wayne.

He was born on June 26, 1950 in Detroit, Michigan, the son of Oswald and Elaine (Liebig) Nielsen. He worked in Quality Control at Bendix in Huntington for 29 years and was a member of the NRA.
