



Martha B. Hummer

January 16, 1930 - January 30, 2016

Martha B. "Myrt" Hummer, age 86, of Huntington, died at 7:20 a.m. Saturday (January 30, 2016) at Tipton Place in Huntington.

Visitation will be from 4 - 7 p.m. Thursday (February 4, 2016) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Friday (February 5, 2016) at Evangelical United Methodist Church, 1000 Flaxmill Road, Huntington with Rev. Dr. Marti Lundy officiating. There will be one hour of visitation prior to the service. Burial will be in Gardens of Memory in Huntington County.

She was also a member of the Huntington County Democratic Party and Past-President of the Horace Mann Parent Teacher Association. She loved to collect sewing thimbles.

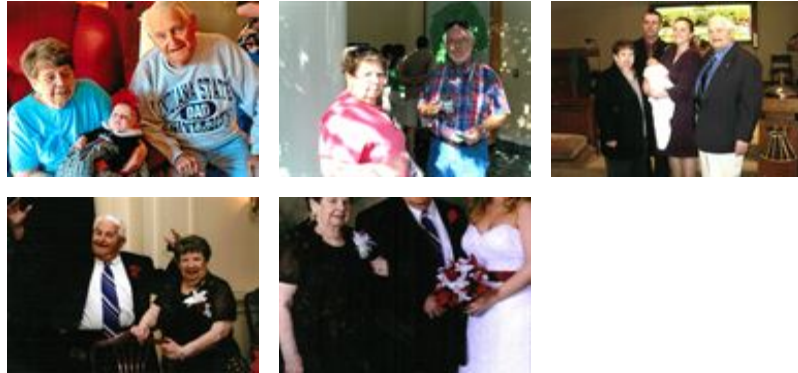
