Mary J. Bradberry, age 48, of Huntington, died at 8:05 p.m. Wednesday, October 11, 2017 at her home.

There will be no public visitation or funeral services. A private memorial service with family will be held at a later date.

Mary was born on October 18, 1968 in Huntington, the daughter of Raymond O. and Janet V. (Veatch) Banker. 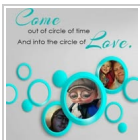
