



Mary B. Brennan

September 7, 1917 - February 15, 2014

Mary B. Brennan, age 96, of Huntington, died peacefully at 5:00 a.m. Saturday February 15, 2014 at her home under hospice care.

Visitation will be held from 3 - 7 p.m. Friday (February 21, 2014) at Bailey-love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana, with rosary service at 7 p.m. conducted by Father John Pfister. Funeral mass will be held at 10:00 a.m. Saturday (February 22, 2014) at SS. Peter and Paul Catholic Church at 860 Cherry Street in Huntington. Father Ron Reider will officiate.

Mary was born on September 7, 1917 in Huntington to John and Pauline (Saluke) Bomersback. She married Robert F. Brennan, owner and operator of Brennan Plumbing and Heating. He preceded her in death on January 7, 2004. She graduated from Huntington High School in 1935. She earned her Bachelor's Degree from Huntington College, and later earned a Master's Degree in Special Education. First, she taught at St. Peter and Paul Catholic School in Huntington. Next, she was able to launch a vision with volunteers and philanthropists for special education in Huntington County which was The Village School; predecessor to Pathfinder Inc. She traveled to speak about special education and the establishment of a one-of-a-kind school, and she authored several articles on the subject. She was involved with various organizations in Huntington County.

Survivors include: two sons - J.T. "Tim" Brennan of Huntington and Jim (Jamie) Brennan of Warsaw; 2 grandchildren - Riley Brennan and Benjamin Brennan, both of Warsaw, and several nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, two brothers - Frank Bomersback and Joe Bomersback, and her sister - Rose Yentes. She was a life member of SS. Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Huntington.
