



## Mary Jesudasan

September 1, 1922 - December 26, 2009

Mary Jesudasan, age 87, of Huntington, died at 5:40 a.m. Saturday (December 26, 2009) at Parkview Huntington Hospital in Huntington.

Mary was born on September 1, 1922 in Coimbatore, India to Mariasoosai and Kanaga Chettiar. She graduated from the Holy Cross High School in Tirichy, India. She received her nursing degree from Visakapattanam University, Visakapattanam, India. In February of 1956, she married Jesudasan in Coimbatore, India. He precedes her in death.

Mary served as a nursing superintendent in India for over 40 years. She was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church and participated in a Bible study group at Ss. Peter & Paul Catholic Church both in Huntington.

Survivors include one daughter – Lourdu Savariar of Huntington; a brother – John Tharsius of Chennai, India; three grandchildren – John, Ann and Susan Savariar of Huntington. Her parents, husband, six brothers – Xavier, Amaldoss, Louis, Rev. Father Thomas, Peter and Benjamin and two sisters – Theresa and Philomena, preceded her in death.

Visitation will be 4:30 – 7 p.m. Monday (December 28, 2009) at the Bailey-Love Mortuary with a Rosary Service held at 4:30 p.m. A Mass of Christian Burial will be at 10 a.m. Tuesday (December 29, 2009) at St. Mary's Catholic

Church, 903 N. Jefferson St. with Father John Pfister , Father Augustine Kochuparathanathu, Father Asir Benedict and Father Loyola Amalraj, of the New York Diocese, officiating. Her ashes will rest in her homeland in India.
