Mary Esther Kohr, 102, of Huntington, passed away peacefully at 8:35 am Wednesday, December 14, 2022, at Heritage Pointe of Huntington.

Mary Esther was born on May 12, 1920, in Huntington, IN, the daughter of A.O. Garretson and Elizabeth (Reed) Garretson. She graduated from Huntington Township High School in 1938 and married Theodore "Ted" Kohr on June 24, 1939, in Huntington County, IN.; he preceded her in death on January 9, 2004. She was a member of the Dallas Township Extension Home Makers from 1944 to 2014, where she was the past president and treasurer. She served two terms on the Huntington County Extension Board. She also served many years on the Democratic Precinct Committee Dallas Precinct #1. Mary Esther was a member of the Central Christian Church of Huntington. She was also a member of the Heritage Guild and Historic Forks of the Wabash. She worked at the A&P Supermarket and retired from Andrews Greenhouse in 1985. Mary Esther was an avid reader. She enjoyed sewing cloth dolls and doll clothes. She took pride as a very experienced colorist, her work was that of perfection. Mary Esther loved volunteering in Chief Richardville House at the Forks of the Wabash and at Sheets Museum.
