Mary Alice (Myers-Schwob) Rickert, 95, of Huntington, passed away at 7:05 am Tuesday, July 13, 2021 at Peabody Retirement Community, North Manchester, IN.

Mary was born on September 7, 1925 in Clear Creek Twp, IN, the daughter of Hildreth D. and Mabel (Wilson) Myers. She was a lifetime resident of Huntington County and lived in Warren Township since 1956. Mary was a 1943 graduate of Clear Creek High School. Her first marriage was to J. Robert Schwob in November of 1946, he died August 27, 1952. Her second marriage was to Robert M. Rickert on April 14, 1956, he died on August 7, 2008.
