



## Mary K. Schenkel

December 8, 1918 - January 25, 2016

Mary K. Schenkel, age 97, of Huntington, died at 8:43 p.m. Monday (January 25, 2016) at Heritage of Huntington.

Visitation will be from 3 - 7 p.m. Friday (January 29, 2016) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Saturday (January 30, 2016) at St. Peter's First Community Church, 206 Etna Avenue, Huntington. There will be one hour of visitation prior to the service. Burial will be in St. Peter's First Cemetery in Huntington.

Preferred memorials are to Cancer Services for Huntington County or St. Peter's First Community Church, in care of Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana, 46750.

Mary was born on December 8, 1918 in Wabash County, Indiana, the daughter of John Ernest and Anna Katherine (Young) Goebel. She graduated from Andrews High School in 1937 and earned an Associate degree from Ball State University and a Bachelor's degree from Huntington College. She married Hayden H. Schenkel on July 25, 1941 in Huntington, and he preceded her in death on July 2, 2009. Mary retired from Huntington County Community School Corporation after 35 years of service. She taught at Bippus High School, Andrews Township, John Tipton School, and Northwest School. She was a member of St. Peter's First Community Church and Women's

Fellowship Circle. She was a member of Indiana Retired Teacher's Association and Huntington County Retired Teacher's Association. She was a member of Beta Chi Chapter, Epsilon Alpha Sorority, and served on the Salvation Army Auxiliary. Mary with her husband oversaw the operations of Cancer Services for Huntington.

Survivors include two sons - Roger Lee (Margaret) Schenkel of Lynnfield, Massachusetts and Ronald Wayne (Brenda) Schenkel of Syracuse; five grandchildren, and seven great grandchildren. She is preceded in death by her parents, husband, and two brothers - Wallace E. Goebel and John A. Goebel.

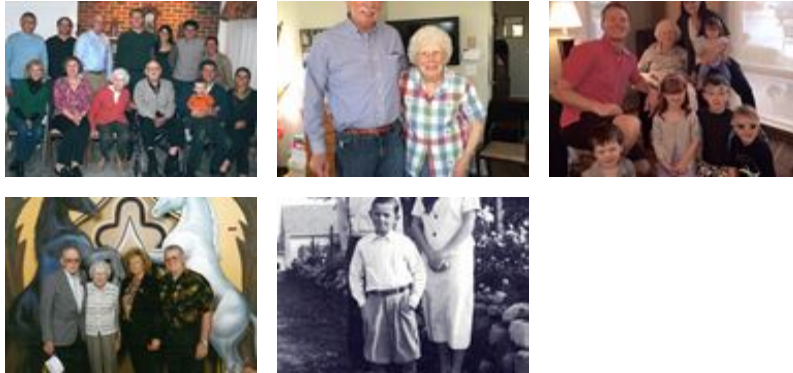
