Mary E. Schnitz, 96, of Huntington, passed away at 3:40 pm Friday, December 27, 2024, at Waters of Huntington.

Mary was born November 24, 1928, in her home of 93 years in Huntington Indiana, to Oma Jacob Kimmel and Bessie (Gordon) Kimmel. She was a 1947 graduate of Huntington High School and worked in the office of Superintendent of Huntington Schools, Schacht Rubber Company and the Transportation Department of the Erie Railroad. 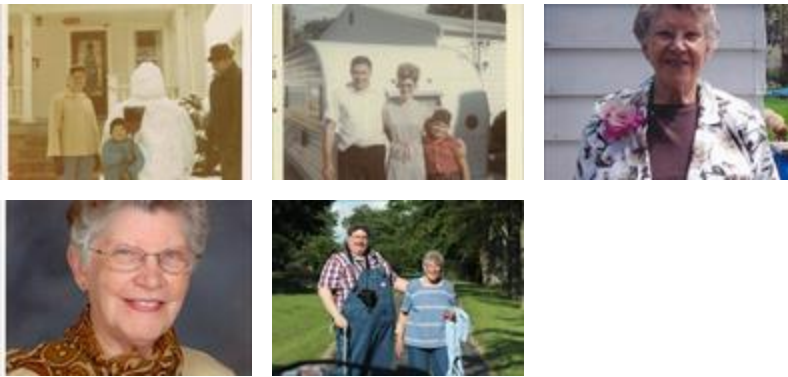
