Mary Alice Shideler, age 95, of Huntington, died at 12:35 p.m. Saturday, May 25, 2019 at Heritage Pointe of Warren.

She was a very active member of St. Peter's First United Church of Christ and participated in the Women's Fellowship of the Church. She loved to bake and travel, and she enjoyed the art classes at Heritage Pointe of Warren.

Survivors include a granddaughter, Kathryn Schilling of Huntington, sisters Gerry Rupel of Huntington and Shirley Clapp of North Manchester, and a son-in-law, Steven Schilling. Mary Alice is preceded in death by her parents, both husbands, a daughter, Mary C.
