



## Mary A. Weir

December 7, 1923 - June 11, 2016

Mary A. Weir, 92, of Huntington, IN, and former resident of Rochester, Indiana, passed away on Saturday, June 11, 2016, at 7:30 p.m., at Heritage of Huntington.

Mrs. Weir was born on December 7, 1923, in Peru, Indiana, to Edgar and Sarah LaVirgia (Dunn) Miller. Her parents preceded her in death. She married Ronald G. Weir, September 16, 1943, in Star City, Indiana. He preceded her in death on March 16, 1964.

Mrs. Weir was a 1941 graduate of Leiters Ford High School, a member of the Richland Center United Methodist Church, a past member of Richland Center IOOF Naomi Rebekah Lodge No. 859, and for over twenty years a dedicated volunteer for the Fulton County Historical Society (FCHS).
