Max L. Burns, age 88, of Huntington, died at 11:39 a.m. Sunday, November 24, 2019 at Heritage Pointe of Huntington.

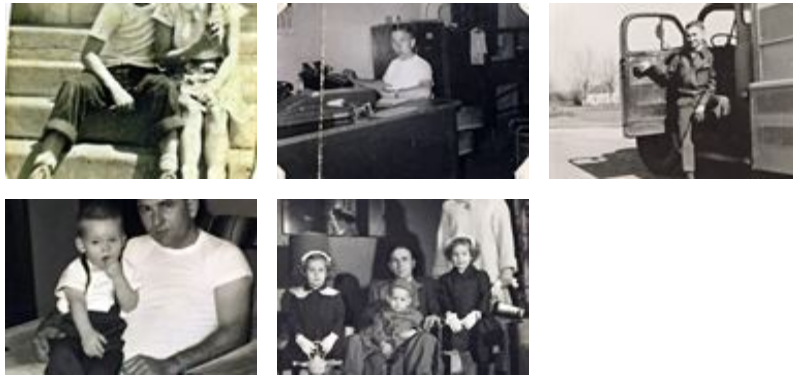
