Max Enyeart, of Huntington, age 82, died at 12:55 a.m. Thursday (December 9, 2010) at the Heritage Pointe, Warren.

Max was born in Huntington on February 17, 1928, the son of Russell Marker and Anna Marie (Taylor) Enyeart. He was a 1946 graduate of West Union High School. Max married Bernice Klemm-Calvert, formerly of Rib Lake, Wisconsin, on June 11, 1950 in Huntington, and she survives.

Max was the owner and operator of the Enyeart Construction Company for over 60 years. He was lifelong Union Township farmer. He was a member of the First Brethren Church. He enjoyed antique tractors.

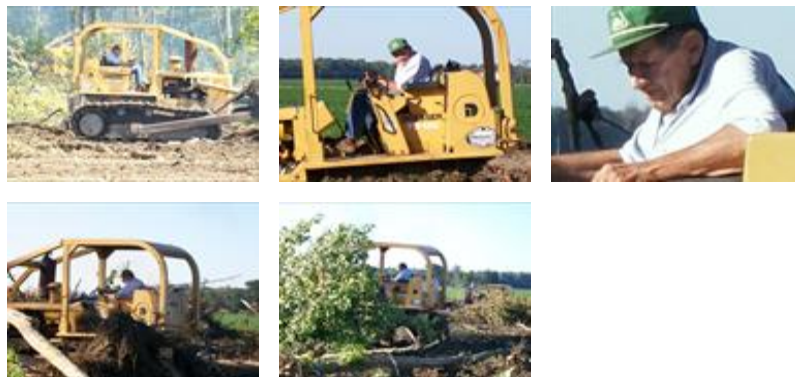
