



## Max Harris

August 27, 1918 - December 23, 2010

Max Harris, of Huntington, age 92, died at 4:30 a.m. Thursday (December 23, 2010) at his home.

Max was born in Huntington, on August 27, 1918, the son of Howard and Flossie (Raber) Harris. He was a 1936 graduate of Rock Creek High School and attended Butler University. Max entered the military in April of 1942 serving with the United States Navy during WW II Asiatic Pacific as Molder First Class. He married Ruth L. Lawrence on January 28, 1945 at the Presbyterian Church in Peru.

Max retired in 1980 from Majestic Company where he worked for over 41 years as manager of the order department. He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church serving as trustee, deacon and elder. He was also a member of the Masonic Amity Lodge F & AM #483, the Scottish Rite Valley of Ft. Wayne, past president of the former Huntington Exchange Club and a past president of the former State of Indiana Industrial Club.

Survivors include his wife of 65 years – Ruth L. Harris of Huntington; one son – Kenneth M. (Beverly) Harris of Huntington; two daughters – Kay L. Harris of Cochise, Arizona and Dianne (Mark) McElhaney of Benson, Arizona; eight grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren. His parents and sister – Jean Ferrell, preceded him in death.

There will be no visitation or funeral services. A Memorial Service will be held at a later date.
