Max L. Husband, age 78, of Huntington, died at 1:58 p.m. Monday, September 11, 2017 at Heritage Pointe in Huntington.

Max was born February 17, 1939 in Huntington, the son of Russell G. and Wanah (Humke) Husband. He graduated from Roanoke High School in 1957 and served in the United States Air National Guard. He was activated in the United States Air Force serving as Airman First Class during the Berlin Crisis. He married Janice A. Paul on October 23, 1960 in Roanoke. For 27 years, Max was a fuel driver for Schenkel Oil Company, delivering fuels for home heating and farming. He then worked at Wabash Magnetics for two years. He

was a member of Emmanuel Community Church in Fort Wayne and loved to sing in church choir and his Gospel quartet. He especially loved his dogs.

Survivors include his wife of 57 years, Janice A. Husband of Huntington, a son - Troy L. (Gayl) Husband of Roanoke, a daughter - Sonya R. Pulley of Cape Coral, Florida, and a brother - Myron (Janet) Husband of Huntington. His parents precede him in death.

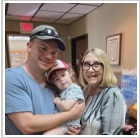
