Max E. Ulrich, age 87, of Huntington, died Monday, January 2, 2017 at his home in Huntington.

Visitation will be from 3 - 7 p.m. Thursday, January 5, 2017 at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Friday, January 6, 2017 at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Rev. Mel Zumbrun officiating. There will be one hour of visitation prior to the service. Burial will be in Lancaster Cemetery in Huntington County.

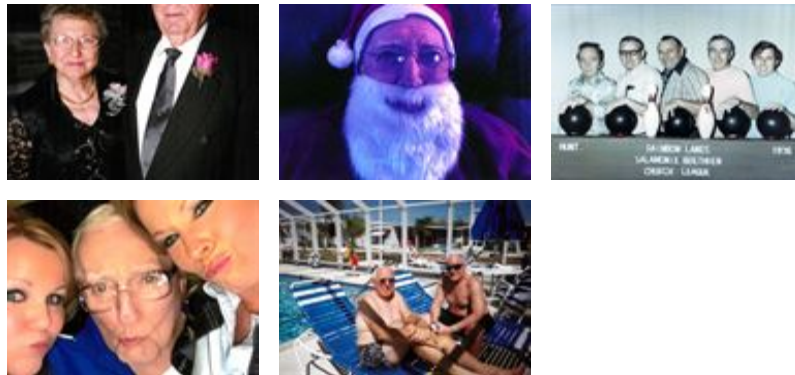
