



Maxine D. "Mick" Leatherman

Maxine D. "Mick" Leatherman, age 91, of Huntington, died at 10:05 p.m. Friday (February 3, 2012) at the Miller's Merry Manor of Huntington.

Mrs. Leatherman was born on October 23, 1920, in Huntington, the daughter of Everett Ray and Dorothy Lee (Adams) Guntle. She was a 1938 graduate of Huntington High School. Mick married Carl Eugene Leatherman on April 17, 1942 in Starke, Florida.

Mick retired from Triad-Utrad of Huntington in 1982 after 15 years of service in the accounts payable office. Prior to that, she worked for the Chicago Motor Club and Huntington Credit Bureau. She was a member of the Central Christian Church and the Order of Eastern Star Floral Chapter #75 both in Huntington.

Mrs. Leatherman is survived by her husband of sixty-nine years – Carl Eugene Leatherman of Huntington, two daughters - Jill Ann Cripe of Carmel and Jan Marie (John) Sink of Yorba Linda, California, 6 grandchildren and 10 great-grandchildren. Her parents and a half brother, Lawrence Day, preceded her in death.
