Maxine Smith, 98, of Fishers, IN passed away at 1:20 am Friday, April 9, 2021 at Riverwalk Village, Noblesville, IN

Maxine was born on August 21, 1922 in Huntington, the daughter of John Wilson and Faye (Shivley) Wilson. She was a 1940 graduate of Huntington High School. She married Elois Ray Smith on December 31, 1941 in Huntington, IN. He preceded her in death on August 2, 2009 after 66 years of marriage. Maxine worked in the offices at Boeing Aircraft in Renton, Washington in 1943 building the new B-17 bomber for the Air Corp.
