Michael E. "Mike" Law, age 67, of Roanoke, died at 4:20 a.m. Wednesday (January 13, 2016) at the Hospice Home in Fort Wayne.

Visitation will be from 3 - 7 p.m. Friday (January 22, 2016) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Saturday (January 23, 2016) at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Pastor Mike Smith officiating. Burial will be in Pleasant Chapel Cemetery in Huntington County.
