Mildred Elizabeth Hedrick, 99, of Huntington, passed away at 12:30 am Thursday, July 31, 2025, at Heritage Pointe of Huntington.

Millie was born on February 28, 1926, in Huntington, IN, the daughter of Henry Aufdenkampe and Mary (Brodrick) Aufdenkampe. She graduated from Huntington Catholic High School with the class of 1944.
