



Mildred Eloise Priddy

February 10, 1918 - December 18, 2010

Mildred Eloise Priddy, 92 (1918-2010), passed peacefully on Saturday, December 18, 2010, after a brief illness. She is survived by her three children, Steven, Tedford, and Tamara and 2 grandchildren, Matthew and Jacquelyn. She is preceded in death by Clarence, her husband of 55 years, twin daughters Connie and Vicky, grandson Joel, brother Paul, and sister Mabel. She had been a resident of Heritage Point Retirement Center for many years. She was a member of the Salamonie Church of the Brethren in Lancaster, Indiana and was recently recognized as being their longest surviving member.

She was born in Roanoke, Indiana and after marrying in 1939, she moved to the family farm near Warren, Indiana. She was the school secretary for the Huntington County School Corporation and after retiring she and her husband wintered in Barefoot Bay, Florida. They also maintained a residence on Little Chapman Lake in Warsaw, Indiana.

Along with being a wife and mother of five, Mildred almost became the first lady pilot in Huntington, Indiana. She had put in her hours of flying instruction and was ready to fly solo when the outbreak of WWII stopped her flying lessons in the late 1930's.
