January 9, 1933 - July 11, 2009

Myrle E. Blair “Pinky Shoemaker”, age 76, of Columbia City, died at 1:43 p.m. Saturday (July 11, 2009) at Parkview Whitley Hospital, Columbia City.

Myrle was born January 9, 1933, in Orrick Missouri, to Russell C. and Nicie (Holloway) Phillips. She was a graduated from high school in 1951. Myrle married Carl “Jack” Edward Shoemaker on October 30, 1950 in Huntington. Jack passed away on November 19, 1969. She later married Michael Blair on August 8, 1980 in Roanoke. Michael also preceded her in death on April 3, 1998. Myrle worked for Wabash Magnetic in Huntington for 20 years and went on to work for the Herald-Press as a paper carrier.

Survivors include two sons – Darrell Shoemaker of Huntington and Lloyd H. Shoemaker of Kimmell, Indiana; one daughter – Janet (Alan) Haneline of Columbia City; 14 grandchildren, 32 great-grandchildren, and 1 great-great-grandchild. Her parents, both husbands, three brothers, one sister and one son – Larry Joe Shoemaker precede her in death.

Visitation will be from 2–3 p.m. with a funeral service 3 p.m Tuesday (July 14, 2009) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington. Reverend Elzie Spencer will officiate. Burial will be at Lancaster Cemetery.

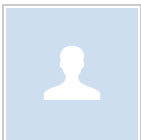
