December 27, 1945 - October 26, 2013

Nam Im "Lee" Beck, age 67, of Huntington, passed away at 2:52 p.m. Saturday (October 26, 2013) at Lutheran Hospital in Fort Wayne, Indiana.

Family will receive friends 3-7 p.m. Tuesday (October 29, 2013) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 a.m. Wednesday (October 30, 2013) at Bailey-Love with Pastor Bob Bruce officiating. Burial will be in Beech Grove Cemetery, Huntington County, Indiana.

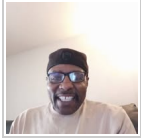

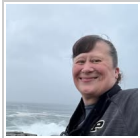

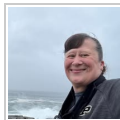
