



## Nancy E. Lintner

February 17, 1937 - December 18, 2017

Nancy E. Lintner, age 80, of Warren, died at 1:15 a.m. Monday, December 18, 2017 at Heritage Pointe in Warren.

Visitation will be from 9:30 - 11:30 a.m. Friday, December 22, 2017 in the Applegate Chapel at Heritage Pointe, 801 Huntington Avenue, Warren, Indiana. A memorial service will immediately follow at 11:30 a.m. Friday in the Applegate Chapel with Chaplain Dick Case officiating. Burial will be in Mt. Hope Cemetery at a later date.
