Nancy A. (Myers) Mackowski, 78, of Huntington, died at 4:00 am Friday, October 16, 2020 at her son Troy's residence in Indianapolis, IN where she had been living while in hospice.

Nancy was born on September 30, 1942 in Bippus, IN, the daughter of Edward Myers and Hazel (Minnear) Myers. She graduated from Huntington High School in 1960. She went to work at Community State Bank the same year having many roles and responsibilities including Head Teller, Branch Manager, and Loan Officer. She retired from Community Bank in 1995. Nancy returned to banking in 1996. She worked at Bippus State Bank from 1996 until 2002 as a Mortgage Loan Officer. Nancy married Jerome Mackowski on July 2, 1998 in Huntington, IN. Nancy was the past President and member of the Epilson Sigma Alpha sorority. She will be remembered for making hundreds of candy wreaths each Christmas. She was also a active member of St. Peter's First Community Church. For many years, Nancy served on the Board and was treasurer for Huntington County HELP, Inc for disabled citizens.
