E-6/TSGT Nicholas Quinn Bradbury, 35, of Huntington, IN and stationed at Fort Bragg, NC died Wednesday, April 21, 2021 at around 9:00 pm in an auto accident.

He was born May 21, 1986 in Huntington, IN. He attended Huntington North High School where he played football his Junior and Senior years. Nicholas played Baseball for Huntington County Baseball for many years and he attended Huntington University for a short time. He worked in Huntington for Carter Lumber and Max Steel and also worked at Menards in Ft. Wayne before entering the Air Force.

Nicholas was an active duty Airman since November of 2007 where he served in the 724th Special Tactics Support Squadron for 5 years as a Vehicle Maintainer. He previously served in the 354th Logistics Readiness Squadron, Eielson AFB, Alaska, and the 23rd Logistics Readiness Squadron, Moody AFB, Georgia. He was awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal and the Air Force Commendation Medal 3 times. He deployed in support of numerous overseas contingency operations in multiple locations including Iraq, Palau, Japan, and Niger, Africa.

Nicholas is survived by his Mother and Step-Father, Dee Ann and Randy Snead of Huntington, IN; his Sister, Krissy (Marcus) Niccum of North

Manchester, IN; Sister, Kami (Jake) Biggs of Huntington, IN; Brother, Bryon (Kathy) Snead of North Manchester, IN; Step-Brother, Eric (Rabecca) McNamara of Florida; Two Half Brothers, Michael (Stephanie) Bradbury and Brent (Nikki) Bradbury; Six Nieces and Six Nephews. His Father, Condan (Susan) Bradbury survives in Roanoke, IN. Nicholas also leaves behind his beloved dog, Harley. He was preceded in death by his Uncle, Wayne Wechsler and his Grandfather, David Wechsler.
