



## Noel D. Denney

June 10, 1939 - October 1, 2015

Noel D. Denney, age 76, of Huntington, died at 5:15 p.m. Thursday (October 1, 2015) at Parkview Regional Medical Center in Fort Wayne.

Visitation will be from 3 - 7 p.m. Tuesday (October 6, 2015) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Wednesday (October 7, 2015) at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Rev. Dr. Marti Lundy officiating. There will be one hour of visitation prior to the service. Burial will be in Gardens of Memory in Huntington County with military graveside rites performed by VFW Post #2689 of Huntington.

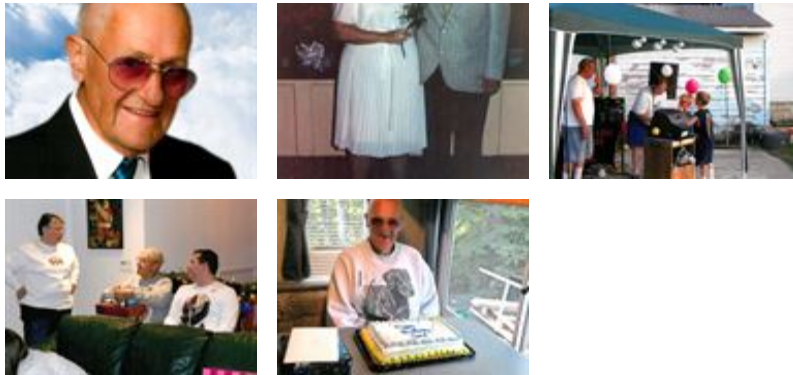
