Norma J. Bair, age 88, of Huntington, died at 11:10 a.m. Thursday, October 17, 2019 at Heritage Pointe of Huntington.

Visitation will be from 3 p.m. – 7 p.m. Monday, October 21, 2019 at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. 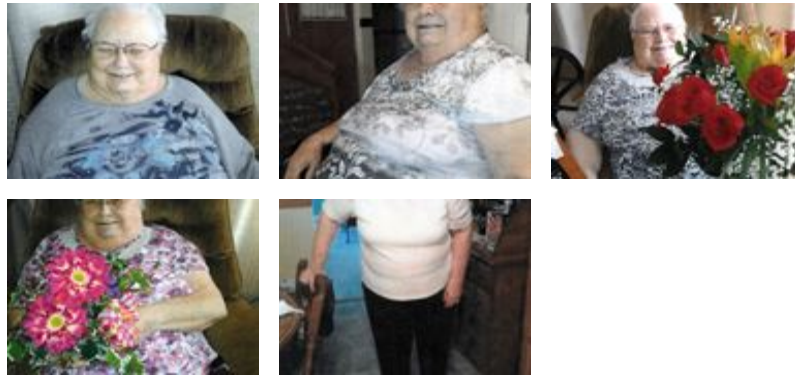
