Norman J. Hinman, age 81, of Huntington, died at 12:15 a.m. Monday (February 15, 2016) at Visiting Nurse and Hospice Home in Fort Wayne.

Visitation will be from 3 - 7 p.m. Wednesday (February 17, 2016) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. Funeral services will be held at 10 a.m. Thursday (February 18, 2016) at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Rev. Robert Land officiating. There will be one hour of visitation prior to the service. Norman was a Clear Creek farmer, and worked at Locke Steel and Chain in Huntington and then as a custodian for 20 years for the Huntington County Community School Corporation. After retiring, he worked for the school corporation as a substitute custodian for 12 more years. He loved gardening and he mowed Funk Cemetery for 50 years.

Survivors include a son - Mark (Christy) Hinman of Huntington; two daughters - Tina (Jim) Sprowl and Tammy (David) Ellis, both of Fort Wayne; five grandchildren and five great grandchildren. He is preceded in death by his parents, his wife, a brother - Harold Hinman, two half-brothers - Homer Londt and Howard Londt, and two half-sisters - Laura Bell Walker and Grace Niedermeyer.
