Oscar Ray Kimery, age 84, of Fort Wayne, died at 12:45 p.m. Friday, December 13, 2019 at his home.

Visitation will be from 10 a.m. – 12 p.m. Thursday, December 19, 2019 at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. A memorial service will immediately follow at 12 p.m. Thursday at Bailey-Love Mortuary with David Kimery officiating.
