



## Pamela S. Wolfe

January 3, 1955 - November 21, 2011

Pamela S. Wolfe, age 56, of Andrews, died at 1:32 a.m. Monday (November 21, 2011) at Visiting Nurse & Hospice Home on Homestead Road in Fort Wayne.

Mrs. Wolfe was born on January 3, 1955, in Huntington, the daughter of Marvin and Beverly Jean (Walters) McBride. She was a 1973 graduate of Huntington North High School and a graduate of Huntington University earning degrees in Elementary Education and Special Education. Pam married Jay L. Wolfe on July 30, 1994 in Andrews on their farm.

Pam retired after 19 ½ years with the Huntington County Community School Corporation. She taught at Huntington North, Andrews Elementary, Central Elementary and Flint Springs Elementary. Prior to her teaching, Pam worked for Lime City Trucking in Huntington. She was a member of Union Church, Huntington County Retired Teachers Association and Retired Indiana Teachers Association. Pam loved her dogs and fostered labs for the C.I.L.R.A.

Survivors include her husband of 17 years - Jay L. Wolfe of Andrews, one sister - Penny (Ken) Collins of Wabash and several nephews and nieces. Her parents preceded her in death.
