Patricia Ann Herman, age 81, of Huntington, died at 4:52 p.m. Friday (November 11, 2011) at her home.

Patricia was born on July 23, 1930, in Mondovi, Wisconsin, the daughter of Charles and Renata (Machmeier) Schreiner. She was a 1948 graduate of Mondovi High School. She continued her education at Stout University of Wisconsin earning a Bachelors Degree in home economics.
