Patricia J. Ludwig, age 85, of Huntington, passed away at 8:10 p.m. Monday (January 27, 2014) at Miller's Merry Manor in Huntington.

Family will receive friends 3 p.m. - 7 p.m. Thursday (January 30, 2014) at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington. Funeral services will be held at 10:00 a.m. Friday at Bailey-Love Mortuary with Pastor Wally Morris officiating. Entombment will be in Gardens of Memory in Huntington County.

Patricia was born on January 26, 1929 in Huntington, daughter of Donald and Gwendolyn (Kaltwasser) Sult. She was part of the Civil Air Patrol during World War II. She married Harold "Half Hitch" Henly on October 16, 1946 in Huntington, and he preceded her in death on December 20, 2000. She married Paul Ludwig in March of 1969 in Huntington and he preceded her in death on August 5, 2004. She managed the Montgomery Ward Department Store in Huntington and Warsaw for many years, from where she retired. Patricia also retired from Our Sunday Visitor after working in the office for several years. She attended Charity Baptist Church and volunteered at Parkview Huntington Hospital. She was a member of the American Business Women's Association and she loved bowling. She traveled to high schools,

middle schools, and nursing classes, speaking to students about the dangers of smoking.

Patricia is survived by one son - Rick (Marcia L.) Henly of Huntington and one daughter - Priscilla "Kay" (Robert) Steele of Huntington; two brothers - David Charles (Kathy) Sult of Fort Wayne and Donald E. (Cora) Sult of Huntington; one sister - Gloria Ann Clore of Ossian; five grandchildren - Tamra Otis of Denver, Colorado, and Shayn Steele, Keela Riker, Jana Henly, and Drew Henly, all of Huntington; eight great grandchildren, and three great-great grandchildren.
