Patricia "Pat" A. Burnau, 92, of Huntington, passed away at 1:51 am Thursday, October 16, 2025, at Heritage Pointe of Huntington.

Pat was born on December 28, 1932, in Lancaster, IN, the daughter of Stanley Allred and Ruth (Smith) Allred. She graduated from Lancaster High School in 1950. Pat married James L. Burnau on March 1, 1953, at Lancaster Church of the Brethren; he preceded her in death on February 2, 1979. 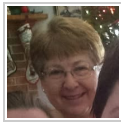

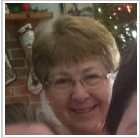
