Paul D. Thompson, age 92, of Warren, died at 12:50 a.m. Friday (November 2, 2012) at the Heritage Pointe, Warren, Indiana.

Paul was born September 7, 1920, in Fort Wayne, Indiana to Max and Gladys (Meeks) Thompson. He graduated in 1938 from North Side High School in Fort Wayne.
