P. Douglas Colbart, age 70, of Huntington, died at 7:59 p.m. Saturday (August 15, 2009) at his home.

Doug was born May 5, 1939, in Angola, Indiana to Donald and Frances (Clark) Colbart. He graduated from Waterloo High School in 1957. Doug married Linda S. Pinkerton on October 18, 1959, in Waterloo, Indiana. He worked for Noll Printing for 32 years and retired from Mignone Communications of Huntington in 2006 after 11 years as a printer.
