Peter Ross Clouser, 85, of Andrews, passed away at 11:41 am Wednesday, March 15, 2023, at Vita Independent Apartments of Marion, IN.

Peter was born on May 12, 1937, in Marion, IN, the son of Earl Clouser and Rowene (Kinney) Clouser. He attended Van Buren High School. Peter proudly enlisted in the United States Navy on January 6, 1955, attending the Ninth Naval District Academy in Great Lakes, IL and the Class "A" Hospital Corps School in Portsmouth VA. He served as a Hospital Corpsman at the U.S. Naval Hospital in Portsmouth VA and aboard the U.S.S. Macon (CA 132) stationed at the U.S. Naval Station in Boston MA. He served until April 30, 1958.

Peter worked for the Veterans Administration Medical Center in Marion IN for 37 years in Nursing Service. He retired from federal service in 1992. Peter married the love of his life Alice Kitt on July 30, 1977, in Fort Wayne. They shared 32 years of marriage before she preceded him in death on August 24, 2009. Peter attended the Andrews United Methodist Church and served on the Andrews Town Board.

Survivors include his daughter, Desiree Clouser of Marion, IN; three sons, Marc Clouser of Marion, IN, Martin (Rachel) Clouser of San Diego, CA, Mel Clouser of Wendover, UT; two stepdaughters, Anna (Mark) Drabenstot of Ft.
