Phylis A. Brumbaugh, 81, of Huntington, died at 12:22 pm Friday, November 20, 2020 at Parkview Regional Hospital in Fort Wayne, IN.

Phylis was born on October 3, 1939 in Huntington, the daughter of John Brumbaugh and Pauline Brumbaugh. She graduated from Andrews High School with the class of 1957. She retired as a self employed Beautician after 50 years, and she worked at Dana Corp for a little while.
