Phyllis Jean Hall, 97, went to be with the Lord on Thursday, March 16, 2023, at 10:10 am surrounded by her family and friends.

Phyllis was born August 6, 1925, in Huntington, IN, the 5th of 14 children to William and Nellie Bartrom. She graduated from Huntington High School with the class of 1943. Phyllis married Marvin M. 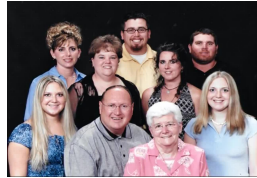
