



## Ralph Eugene Click

November 23, 1924 - October 27, 2016

Ralph Eugene Click, age 91, of Roanoke, died Thursday, October 27, 2016 at Indiana University Methodist Hospital in Indianapolis.

Visitation will be from 3 - 7 p.m. Monday, October 31, 2016 at Bailey-Love Mortuary, 35 West Park Drive, Huntington, Indiana. He loved to do Sudoku puzzles and write poems and short stories. In his younger years, he played in a country western band. He and his wife visited all 50 states, mostly by RV.
