



## Ralph E. Stout

November 8, 1922 - January 19, 2012

Ralph E. Stout, age 89, of Huntington, died at 4:45 p.m. Thursday (January 19, 2012) at his daughter's home in Highpoint, North Carolina.

Ralph was born November 8, 1922, in Van Buren, to Alford E. and Mabel (James) Stout. He graduated from Van Buren High School in 1940 and attended Indiana Business College. Ralph served with the United States Army Air Corp during WW II as a Staff Sergeant. He married Imogene M. Bradford on December 17, 1949 at Landess Christian Church, Grant County.

Ralph retired from Dana Corporation in Marion after 35 years of service. He also farmed in Dallas Township in Huntington County. Ralph was a member of the Van Buren Central Christian Church and the United Steel Workers Union Retiree Local #113 in Marion.

Survivors include two sons - Gary C. (Cindy) Stout of Huntington and Bradley J. Stout of Huntington; four daughters - Dinah (Ray) Kimery of Fortville, Indiana, Sheila Koontz of High Point, North Carolina, Melba Stout of Huntington and Jeana (Michael) Mundy of Andrews; one brother - James Ray Stout of Van Buren; one sister - Louise Martin of Ranbourne, Alabama; sixteen grandchildren and twelve great-grandchildren. His parents, wife and son, Stanley Stout, preceded him in death.

Visitation will be from 3 - 7 p.m. Monday (January 23, 2012) at the Bailey-Love Mortuary. Funeral services will be at 10 a.m. Tuesday (January 24, 2012) at Bailey-Love Mortuary Rev.
